Enclose in the static bag is a 64K memory expander for the Adam (tm) Home Computer. Caution, it can be damaged by a static charge. To insure a long life for the board, only handle it once when you install it.

To install the expander, remove power from the ADAM and and pry the top off the computer memory console. A small common screw driver may be used. Carefully remove the new board from the bag and insert it into slot number three on the right side with the components facing the right. Close the top and re-apply power. If you have CP/M (tm) you can load it and log onto the M drive as described in the CP/M manual. If not, operation can be verified with a good RAM diagnostic, available from the dealer.

Operation is for the most part un-noticed by the user. If the computer "acts funny", remove the expander (power Off) and verify that it still functions normally. If there is a problem, return the the expander to dealer for repair or replacement. If the expander fails after 1 year, contact your dealer for repair.

This memory expander is warranted for a period of one year to be free from defects in materials or workmanship. The manufacturer will not assume responsibility for the use of this product or any damages incurred as a result of the use of this product nor will he be responsible for loss of data caused by the use of the expander.
