CONNECTING YOUR ADAM™ TO A MONITOR IS EASY!

Use the Adapters and Cable provided to connect your ADAM'* system quickly and easily to almost any standard video monitor.

- 1. Turn Adam' and your monitor off.
- 2. Insert the 7-pin plug into the aux. video jack on the back of the memory console as shown in Fig. 1. Please note that the plug only fits in correctly one way. Do not try
- 3. Connect the red RCA phono plug to the monitor's video input as shown in Figure 2. NOTE: If your video input has a BNC connector, as shown in Figure 3, you must use the adaptor pictured in the inset.
- 4. Connect the black RCA phono plug to the monitor's audio input as shown in Figure 4. NOTE: If the monitor's audio input has a miniature phono jack, as shown in Figure 5, the adaptor pictured in the inset must be used.
- 5. Caution: If you are using an ADAMLink' modem with your system, remember to keep this cable away from the modem cable. This will prevent interference during modem calls.
