IMPORTANT DEFINITIONS

STORAGE Drive:

The designated drive letter to **LOAD** data when starting the BBS and **SAVE** data when shutting down.

RUN Drive:

The designated drive letter to auto-copy data for optimized BBS speed. (Select

your FASTEST drive if possible).

ADAMBBS requires ALL 7 of these BBS system files to launch

Non-Customizable Text File: USERFILE.BBS

User-Customizable System Text Files:

MENU.BBS BRDLIST.BBS LIBLIST.BBS INFO.BBS NEWS.BBS OTHERBBS.BBS

Additional 8TH REQUIRED User-Customizable System Text File (for Pro Edition ONLY): GREET.BBS

MESSAGES.BBS is the optional system file to store messages when shutting down the BBS or load them again when starting it. It will ALWAYS be saved at shutdown unless there are no messages in RAM, or you choose to cancel the save operation when prompted for media.

WARNING: NEVER manually edit the USERFILE.BBS or MESSAGES.BBS files outside of approved BBS operations or utilities. Corruption to the layout of these 2 files will cause malfunctions. You may always make renamed COPIES of these files to review, archive, or edit manually outside of the BBS.

Known Issues:

[Issue 1] A very specific and easily avoidable situation may cause incorrect BBS system file copies onto the RUN drive. The auto-copy RUN drive feature (when used with a <u>different STORAGE drive</u>) is intended to be <u>temporary</u> storage to optimize BBS display speed. If the BBS is launched with pre-existing BBS system files on the RUN drive, and then auto-copies smaller versions of those files from the STORAGE drive, the resulting RUN file copies may have incorrect or old data.

[Workaround 1] PLEASE be sure to erase any existing ".BBS" system files from the temporary RUN drive prior to launching the BBS. Doing this ensures the STORAGE drive always has the intended permanent data files.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Boot your **CP/M operating system** while noting your drive letter assignments for later use. If using a single drive to boot <u>and</u> run the program, do not enter any CP/M commands until AFTER inserting the **ADAMBBS** disk or DDP tape.
- 2. Type the program name **ADAMBBSV** to launch the **free Vintage Edition BBS.** Follow the guided steps specifying drive letters where needed. You MAY use drive letters more than once if needed. **For example,** everything CAN be on **Drive A:**
- 3. Set the DATE according to the format displayed on the screen. This will be used in message postings and caller logs. You may wish to log into the BBS and use the DATE command to periodically update the DATE field or the AM/PM indication. ADAM hardware does not have a built-in real-time clock.
- 4. A primitive **EDITUSER** program has been included to safely edit **USERFILE.BBS** accounts and security access when needed. This program was previously called **UFEDIT** and may still contain this old program name on screens.
- 5. Each user account has a 3-character security level code. The Vintage Edition security defaults for new users are "2@@". You may wish to update user accounts with different security levels to allow or prevent using the various BBS commands listed in this documentation. When changing the security code, only alter the first character. The trailing "@@" characters are only used in ADAMBBS Pro Edition and should not be changed in ADAMBBS Vintage

Edition.

- 6. The default **USERFILE.BBS** starts with **0** account records and will <u>automatically</u> assign manager privileges (**SYSOP**, security code **9**) to the FIRST newly-created account (**User# 000**). If you ever need to re-create the original <u>blank</u> file, first <u>erase</u> the existing file. Then enter **"SAVE 0 USERFILE.BBS"** at the CP/M command prompt.
- 7. The program will update the **USERFILE.BBS** when needed. For security this filename is automatically protected from download by any users. You may safely assign the same drive letter to your FILE TRANSFER LIBRARY as your STORAGE or RUN drives if desired. Just be sure you don't have any copies or backups of sensitive files saved under names which CAN be downloaded.
- 8. Files UPLOADED to the BBS from callers are named with a high bit set causing the filename font to appear reversed. This security function intentionally prevents users from downloading newly received files that you have not yet approved for distribution. You may reset this situation at the CP/M prompt (after shutting down the BBS) by copying or renaming the uploaded files and checking the directory to see they appear with the normal font color.
- 9. All fields in **USERFILE.BBS** have limited lengths. For example, PASSWORD is up to 8 characters, and ignores case. There may be up to 256 different user accounts in this file. Account numbers may be marked for deletion and later reissued by setting the first character of their security level code to the **"*"** asterisk character. Use the **EDITUSER** program or the **BBS Chat Mode** to change security.

10. When shutting down the BBS program, you will be returned to the CP/M system. If the loaded disk or DDP tape is not bootable CP/M media, you will get

a CP/M warning such as "Bad System, Retry on A:" Simply insert bootable media and press return.
