COLECO ANNOUNCES SOFTWARE LINES FOR ATARI, COMMODORE AND APPLE COMPUTERS

Chicago, CES -- Coleco has announced that it will produce and market a number of its most popular software titles for a variety of computer systems, including the Atari Computers, the Commodore 64 and the Apple IIe and IIc.

Currently planned for release are selected titles from both Coleco's entertainment and educational software categories.
